

AIR QUALITY PERMIT NOTICE
Draft Title V Operating Permit V-12-019 R2
John Sherman Cooper Power Station
Plant I.D. 21-199-00005 - Agency Interest 3808

East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. of 4775 Lexington Road, Winchester, KY, has applied to the Kentucky Division for Air Quality for a permit to operate a fossil fuel electric power generation facility at John Sherman Cooper Power Station, located on State Highway 1247 South in Burnside, Kentucky. The plant is classified as a Title V major source due to its emissions of regulated air pollutants and hazardous air pollutants above major source thresholds.

The Division is soliciting comments on the draft permit. A public hearing has been scheduled on Wednesday March 16th, 2016, at the Pulaski County Court House, 100 North Main Street, Suite 204, Somerset Kentucky at 6:00 PM Eastern Daylight Time. If no one contacts the Division to request a public hearing before March 14th 2016, it will be cancelled. Comments should be sent to Ms. Shauna Switzer at the above Frankfort address. All relevant comments will be considered in issuing the proposed permit. To be considered, any written comments must be postmarked within 30 days following the date of this notice. U.S. EPA has up to 45 days following the issuance of the proposed permit to submit comments.
