

**KENTUCKY DIVISION FOR AIR QUALITY  
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSED  
REVISION TO THE KENTUCKY STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN**

The Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet will conduct a public hearing on April 19, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. (Local Time) in Conference Room 201B at the Kentucky Division for Air Quality Central Office, 200 Fair Oaks Lane, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Frankfort, Kentucky, to receive comments on a proposed revision to Kentucky's State Implementation Plan (SIP). This SIP revision includes a variance to the Stage II vapor recovery controls requirement on gasoline fuel dispensers at the Enterprise Holdings, Inc. car rental facility being constructed at the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport, located in Boone County.

This hearing is open to the public and all interested persons will be given the opportunity to present testimony. The hearing will be held, if requested, at the date, time, and place given above. It is not necessary that the hearing be held or attended in order for persons to comment on the proposed submittal to EPA. To assure that all comments are accurately recorded, the Division requests that oral comments presented at the hearing also be provided in written form, if possible. To be considered part of the hearing record, written comments must be received by the close of the hearing. Written comments should be sent to the contact person. If no request for a public hearing is received, the hearing will be cancelled, and notice of the cancellation will be posted at the website listed below. Request for a public hearing must be received no later than April 11, 2013, while all written comments must be submitted no later than April 19, 2013.

The full text of the proposed SIP revision is available for public inspection and copying during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) at the locations listed below. Any individual requiring copies may submit a request to the Division for Air Quality in writing, by telephone, or by fax. Requests for copies should be directed to the contact person.
